Advent: The Biblical Roots

Though it's never explicitly mentioned in the Bible, Advent is inspired by scripture. Isaiah, a messianic prophet, foretold Jesus's birth centuries before it took place:

Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign; the young woman, pregnant and about to bear a son, shall name him Emmanuel. (Isaiah 7:14)

In the Gospels, we see the fulfillment of this prophecy.

Now the birth of Jesus the Messiah took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been engaged to Joseph, but before they lived together, she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit. Her husband Joseph, being a righteous man and unwilling to expose her to public disgrace, planned to dismiss her quietly. But just when he had resolved to do this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife, for the child conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. She will bear a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins." All this took place to fulfill what had been spoken by the Lord through the prophet:

"Look, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel,"

which means, "God is with us." When Joseph awoke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him; he took her as his wife, but had no marital relations with her until she had borne a son; and he named him Jesus. (Matthew 1:18-25) <https://hallow.com/advent/>

The Woman's Prayer Group

The Woman's Prayer Group continues its Advent journey with **Week 2: The Way of the Saints** from "Prepare Your Heart: A Guided Advent Journal for Prayer and Meditation" by Fr. Agustino Torres, CFR. "Lord Jesus, you surround me with so many holy saints. Through the Intercession of your mother and St. Juan Diego, instill in my heart a burning desire to be holy. Amen."



As we enter the second week of Advent, we realize that often, all our good intentions get lost amid the bright lights and celebrations of the Christmas season it precedes.

The second week of Advent is particularly significant as we reflect on the meaning of faith, which is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. In ancient times, the people were foretold of a messiah who would be named “Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins” and be called “Immanuel, which means God with us.” They had faith that one day, the Savior would come, and He did! Maybe not as they expected, but as God intended – in the form of a poor, innocent child born in a manger.

Let us refocus our attention and recommit to our spiritual intentions. I urge you to take a moment to balance holiday busyness with spiritual reflection and preparation for Christmas. During Advent, we light candles and meditate on the story of Christ's birth, reminding ourselves of the humble beginnings of our Savior. We are encouraged to focus on the meaning of our faith and anticipate Christ's coming among us.

As we light the second purple candle, called the “Bethlehem Candle,” we contemplate Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem. We are reminded of the faith that comes with the knowledge that God keeps his promises. As we light this candle and meditate on the story of Christ's birth, may we be filled with hope and faith, worshiping infant Immanuel and believing in our hearts that God is always with us.

Nursing homes, rehabilitation centers and anyone who is hospitalized are not permitted to contact the church. If someone you know is in the hospital, please call the church office.

In case of serious or life threatening sickness or the actively dying: The church should be contacted as soon as possible.

People deserve the opportunity to confess their sins, profess their faith, be anointed, and receive Holy Communion – the foretaste and pledge of eternal life. PLEASE don't wait until after the person is unconscious or so sedated that he or she cannot communicate. It is imperative with current situations, that there be enough time for Fr. to go through the appropriate protocol to visit the actively dying.

To report an incidence of suspected child sexual abuse, please contact your local law enforcement agency, or you may confidentially contact WV Child Protective Services at 800.352.6513. To report suspected cases of sexual abuse by personnel of the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston to the Diocese, please notify civil authorities first and then please contact the Diocese at 888.434.6237 or 304.233.0880.
